

Dispensations:

These are required if you plan to marry a person who is not a Roman Catholic. This obligation exists in order to protect and respect the religious convictions of both parties.

1. If you are marrying another baptised Christian, you will need to write to your Bishop as a canonical requirement for reception of the sacrament.
2. If you are marrying outside of the Christian tradition, a canonical dispensation will be required from your Bishop.

The priest of the Parish where you live will be glad to give you any advice or guidance which you may require on these matters.
